The UOM for your product is now displayed in a table format. Each attribute marked with an asterisk is a required field and must be populated for each UOM listed.

Here is some additional information to assist you when filling out unit of measure (UOM) table:

- CV (Master Case): Pack Quantity/Multiplier is the number of individual selling items in the case.
- EA (Each): the base unit of measure. Consider this: You are selling **one** individual unit to customer, therefore; the Multiplier/Pack Quantity for EA is 1.
- IP (Inner Pack): the Pack Quantity/Multiplier for an IP is how many individual selling items (EAs) are in the Inner Pack. It is NOT how many inner packs are in a case.
- Refer to the Supplier Attribute List by Role Job Aid for detailed descriptions of each attribute.
